Dear Parents/Carers,

Now that we are nearing the end of week 2 of Remote learning I wanted to just update you with a few minor changes to systems and processes with regards to work.

We have developed a clear system of expectations and structures for all lessons which I published on the website on Monday. We have been informed by the DfE that they now expect 5 hours of remote learning a day rather than 4 and so we have made a slight tweak to the published timetable (see below).

Each subject session should take an hour to complete and be assessed using a Quiz on Microsoft Teams-again this can be easily accessed through any mobile, PC, laptop, or tablet. We have included clear times for break and lunch for Scholars to help organise their day. Work will usually be on Teams by 9am each day with the Civics and Reading work uploaded every Monday for the entire week.
