Start of 2022-23 academic year

I hope you have enjoyed the summer break. We are looking forward to welcoming all of our students back to the academy on Monday. As the new term begins, I would like to update you on some key changes here at Kirk Hallam.

Children's Services Team

The Children's Services Team has been developed to bring together a number of support areas across the school. This includes Learning Support, Pastoral Support, and our new provision – Wellbeing Support. The development of this new team includes changes to pastoral staff leading each year group.

- Miss Kingham is now the Year Leader for Year 7 and transition
- Mrs Thornhill is now the Year Leader for Years 8 and 9
- Mrs Briggs is now the Year Leader for Years 10 and 11.

Year Leaders will be supported in their roles by our support staff - Miss Hibbert, who is our Pastoral Support Leader, and Miss Merritt, who is our Student Adviser. Mr Harrison-Hill is our Wellbeing Support Leader. In addition, there will also be a member of the Senior Leadership Team linked to each year group.

Our Pastoral Support staff are now based in the Children's Services Hub, which is located at student reception. As always, your child's form tutor is the first port of call for pastoral matters (things like behaviour, wellbeing, friendship issues) but the broader Children's Services Team are always on hand to provide support and guidance when needed. We will be talking to the students about the new team on their return to school.

School Day

Following the summer term consultation, can I please remind all parents and carers that the new Kirk Hallam school day is in place from September 2022. All school days now start at 8.30am and end at 3.05pm. All students should ensure they are on site by 8.25am so they arrive at class in good time.
