Dear parents and carers

ParentPay and dinner money accounts

At the beginning of the academic year, we would like to clarify arrangements around payment of school dinners, as a reminder to years 8 to 11 and to inform families of new year 7s. There are limitations on ParentPay to enable our finance team to control dinner money spends.
