In lessons

We take responsibility by:

- Lining up at the door, single file, in a calm manner, ready to greet your teacher
- Placing your equipment on the desk – planner, pencil case and character card
- Sitting in silence for the register
- Putting your hand up if you have a question and waiting your turn
- Not talking over others 'One Voice'
- Keeping voices low and using a calm and respectful tone
- Keeping water bottles out of sight and off tables
- Not chewing or eating in class

Assemblies

We take responsibility by:

- Queuing single file, in alphabetical order by surname, facing your teacher
- Entering the assembly hall only when instructed, in silence
- Proceeding to your allocated seat
- Removing your coat and checking your uniform
- Placing your bag and coat under your seat
- Facing forwards, ready to learn
- Exiting the hall in silence, only when dismissed by a member of staff

Breakfast, break and lunchtime

We take responsibility by:

- Not crossing the 'break and lunch learning line'
- Entering the canteen quietly and sensibly
- Queuing for food or drinks in an orderly manner
- Not queue jumping, pushing or using raised voices
- Only eating in designated areas
- Placing all litter in the bins provided to respect our environment
- Participate in activities sensibly and kindly

Use of toilets

We take responsibility by:

- Only using the toilet before school, at break, lunch, or after school
- Using break and lunch time effectively to plan your toilet break
- Using a yellow lanyard issued by staff when using a toilet in lesson time, in an emergency
- Having your character card signed if you leave the class
- Never entering a cubicle with another student
- Treating facilities with respect and care


